She gave 7 of them away.

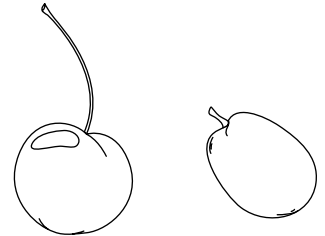
How many baseball cards does Kira have left?



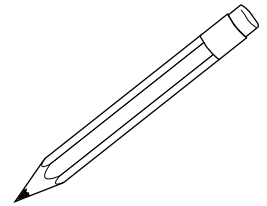
